## Proof of Eligibility for COVID-19 vaccination

Victoria has reserved COVID-19 vaccine appointments for Specified Worker (Multiple Entry) Permit holders, who have obtained the permit because they are required to enter and exit the state as a freight driver. These appointments are open to all individuals with a specified worker permit.

### To make an appointment

If you would like to access a reserved appointment, you must call the Coronavirus Hotline on **1800 675 398** and advise the operator that you are a **Commercial Freight Worker**.

The operator will ask you a series of questions to confirm your eligibility.

### If you have been to a Red or Extreme Risk Zone in the past 14 days

Workers who have been in a red or extreme risk zone in the past 14 days must attend a vaccination centre with a **red zone clinic** and follow strict instructions at the point of vaccination..

**Red Zone clinics** appointments are available at the following state vaccination centres:

- **Melbourne Showgrounds**
- **Sunshine**
- **Sandown Racecourse Drive-Through** (*regular car only, from Thursday 2 September*)
- **Ford Campbellfield** (*from Thursday 2 September*)
- **Wangaratta** (*from Thursday 2 September*)

### If you have NOT been to a Red or Extreme Risk Zone in the past 14 days

You can book an appointment at any Victorian state vaccination centre, GP clinic, community pharmacy or Aboriginal Controlled Community Health Organisation.

### Please bring to your appointment:

- Photo identification (driver licence, passport or proof of age card)
- Medicare card or [Individual Health Identifier](#) number (if you have one)
- Negative test results date no earlier than 72 hours before your appointment (red zone workers only)
- This letter or a letter from your employer as **proof of eligibility** (digital copy is acceptable).

### **Before you get vaccinated**

- If you have received a first dose of AstraZeneca you will be offered the same again for your second vaccination.
- You should wait at least 7 days after the flu vaccine to receive a dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.
