

Construction notice

August 2021

Brisbane City Council is moving ahead with delivering the turn-up-and-go Brisbane Metro, which will revolutionise public transport in our city.

A significant milestone will be reached in early September 2021, when Brisbane Move starts major construction activities in Brisbane's Central Business District (CBD). These works will continue until 2024.

The first stages of construction on North Quay, William Street, George Street and Adelaide Street will include:

- site establishment, including installing traffic barriers and hoarding around work areas
- temporary and permanent changes to general traffic, pedestrian movements, bus stops and motorcycle parking
- service installation and relocation works
- construction of the portal for the new Adelaide Street tunnel, between North Quay and George Street.

Intermittent site investigation works will continue in the area during major construction activities.

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of these works on nearby businesses and residents.

Brisbane Metro is a new mode of transport that will transform the way we move around our city and is another way Brisbane City Council is investing in our city's growth and making our future better.

KEY CHANGES FROM 20 SEPTEMBER 2021

Permanent traffic and pedestrian changes

- Through southbound vehicle access on North Quay **will permanently close** at Adelaide Street. All general traffic will need to turn left from North Quay into Adelaide Street. Once on Adelaide Street, all general traffic will then need to turn left into George Street. Buses and authorised vehicles will be able to continue eastbound on Adelaide Street. For general CBD access, please seek an alternative route.
- The signalised pedestrian crossing across Adelaide Street at North Quay **will permanently close**.

Traffic management will be in place to guide motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists.

Temporary motorcycle parking changes

Approximately 40 motorcycle parks will be **temporarily removed** until mid-2022 on North Quay, near Turbot Street.

Signage will be installed prior to this closure.

Permanent changes to bus stops and services from 20 September 2021

- Bus stop 109/110 on North Quay (the North Quay Island stop) **will permanently close**.
- Bus stop 48 on Adelaide Street will be **closed during major construction**.
- Bus services currently using these stops will be re-routed through the Brisbane CBD to service alternative bus stops.

KEY CHANGES FROM 20 SEPTEMBER 2021



What to expect

During major construction, nearby residents and businesses can expect:

- **work hours (both standard and out-of-hours):**
 - Standard hours: Monday to Friday, from 7am to 6pm, and Saturday, from 8am to 1pm
 - Out-of-hours: Sunday to Thursday, from 7pm to 5am
- **noise, dust and light** – some noise, dust, vibration and light can be expected from the use of construction machinery
- **pedestrian changes** – pedestrian detours and diversions around the work areas will be in place
- **traffic changes** – temporary lane closures and traffic detours will be in place
- **vegetation removal** – may be required and will be undertaken in accordance with Brisbane City Council's Natural Assets Local Law.
